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
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## Rogers Memorial: Administration Building


#### Main Work Stations



Clockwise: Top: Training Room; Bottom Right: Private Office Typical; Bottom Left: Reception Area






#### Reception and Custom Conference Table


The Reception and Conference Rooms are meant to create impact and bringing old and new elements of the company together, such existing vintage pieces, and new lounge furniture and custom furniture.





- Integrate cantilevered, height adjustable tables, over layered storage.
- Include panel-inserted paper management
- Include a layered array of finishes, to compliment and unify both new and existing architecture.




#### Private Offices




#### Break Room

This area of the space is purposely designed to look like a sophisticated picnic area, while allowing for various types of collaboration










First & Second Floor Furniture Plans Not To Scale






#### Reception & Break Room

- The Break room serves as the retreat of the building, encouraging friendly communication, access to outside, and a refreshing aesthetic.












#### South Side Stations (Call Center)


























