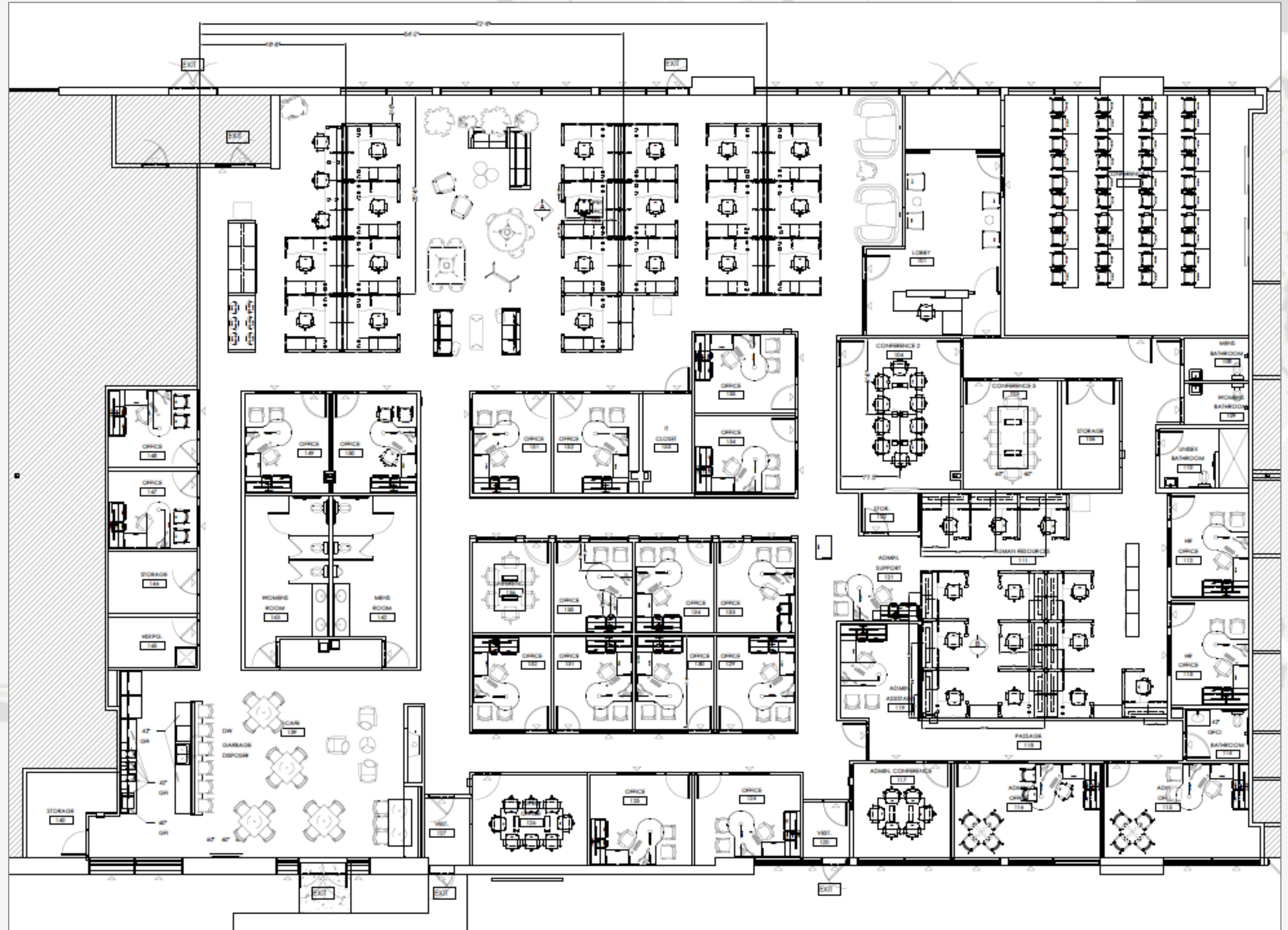
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# Rogers Memorial: Administration Building

# Rogers Memorial: Administration Building

## Main Work Stations

- Allow for access to daylight and work lounges.
- Provide privacy, while being open with 50H panels and frameless glass toppers on the shared aisleways.
- Offer shared upper storage and marker board overheads, lower filing, and an inverse swell main work surface for optimum efficiency.

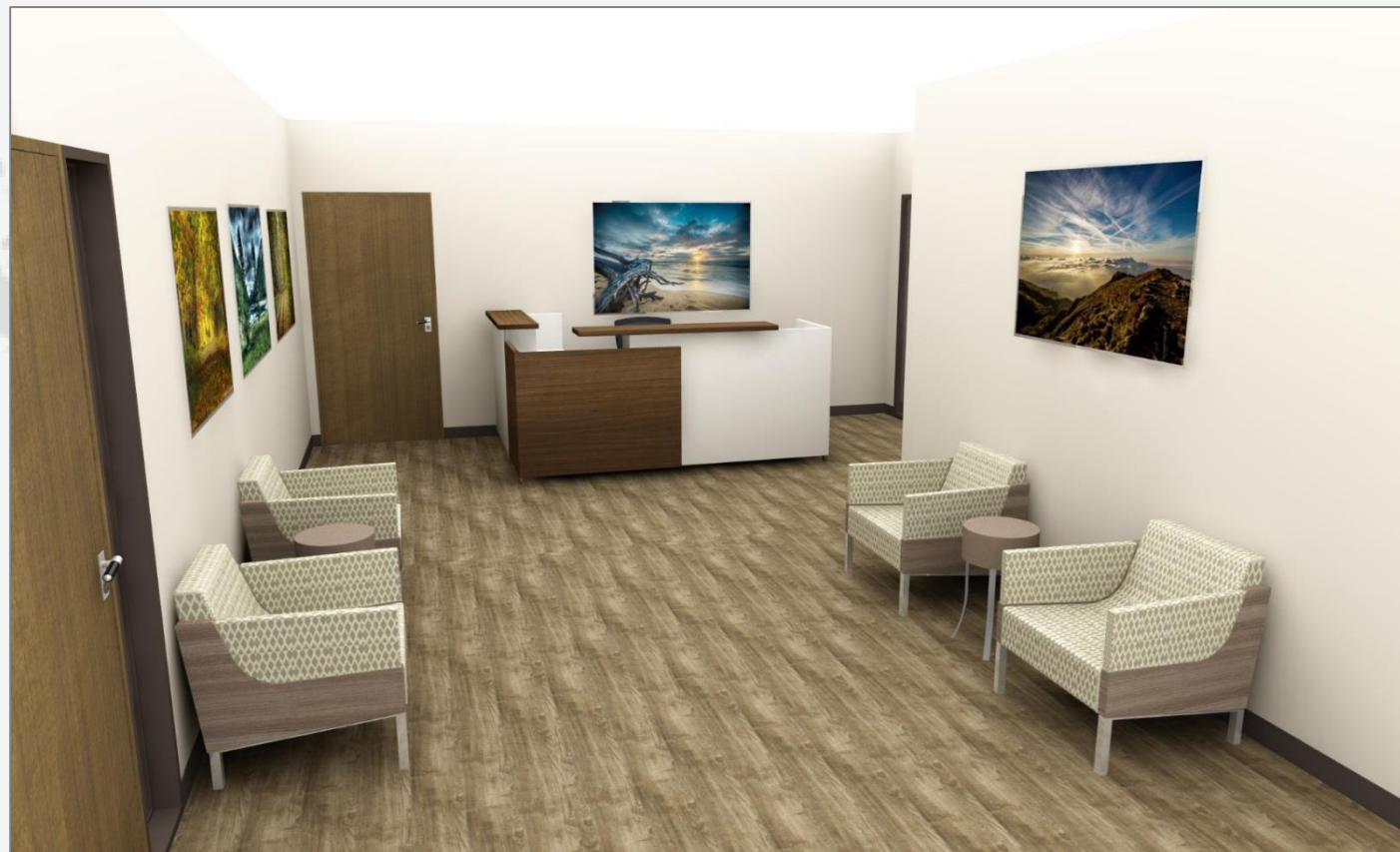
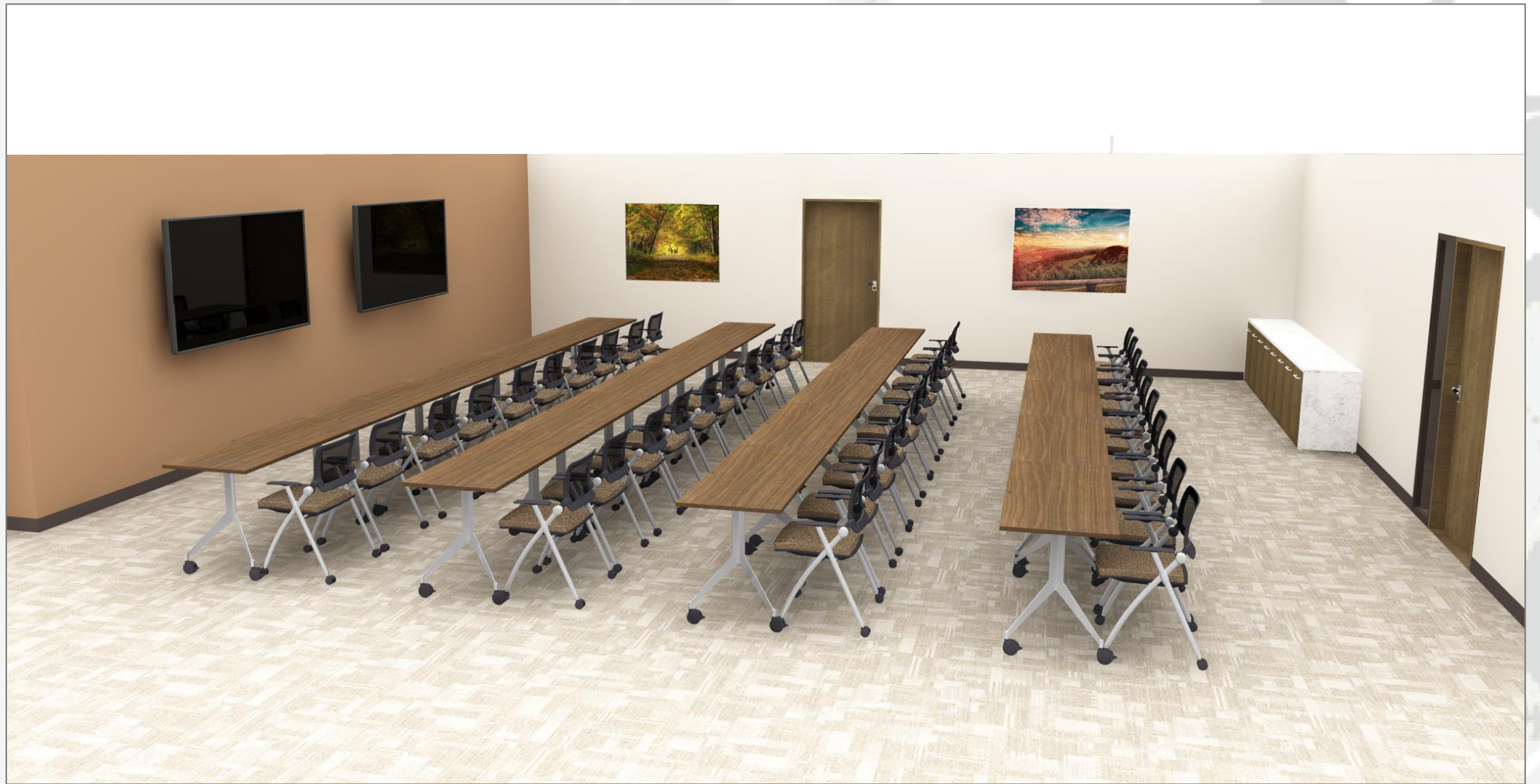

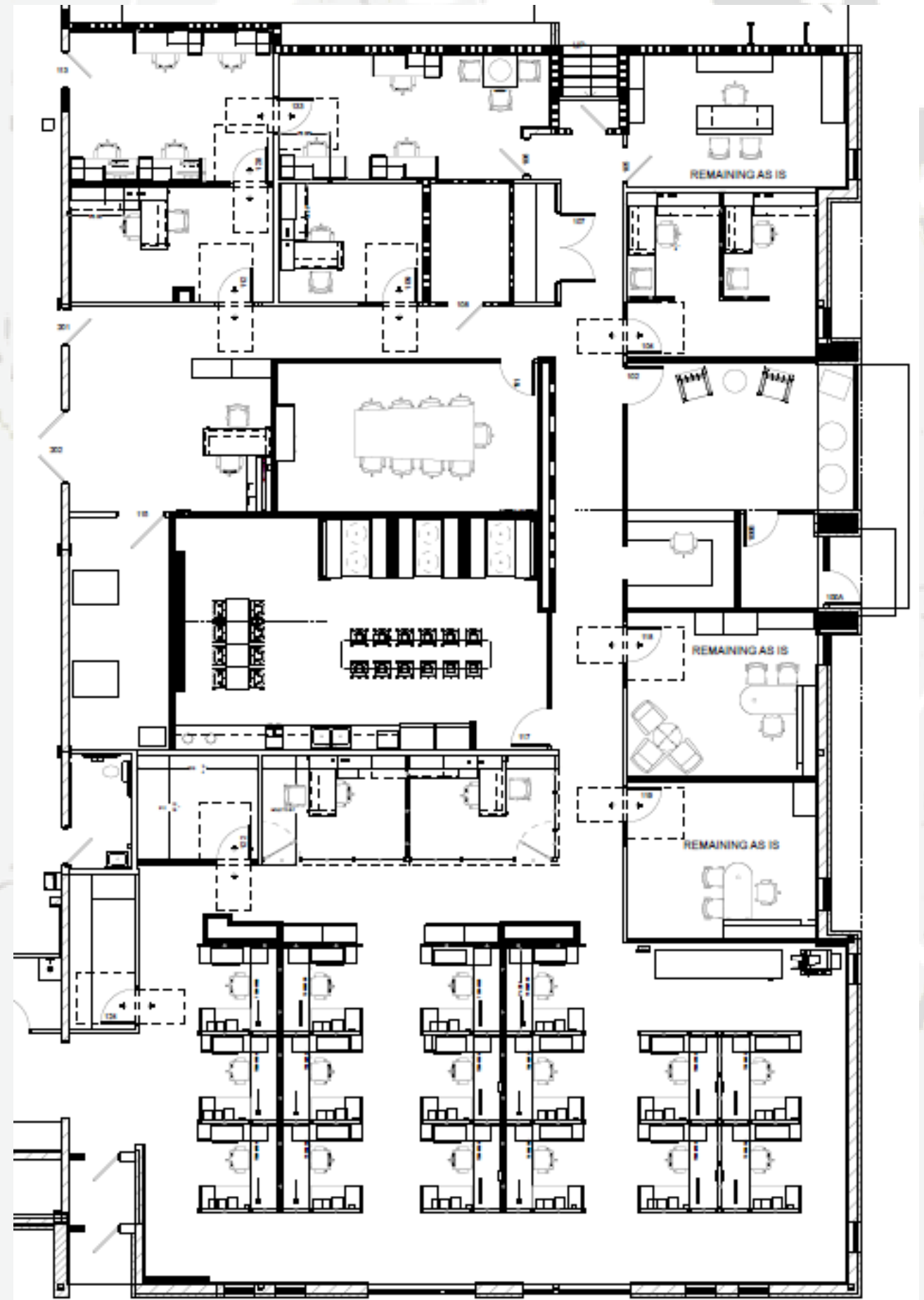


# Badger Liquor Renovation

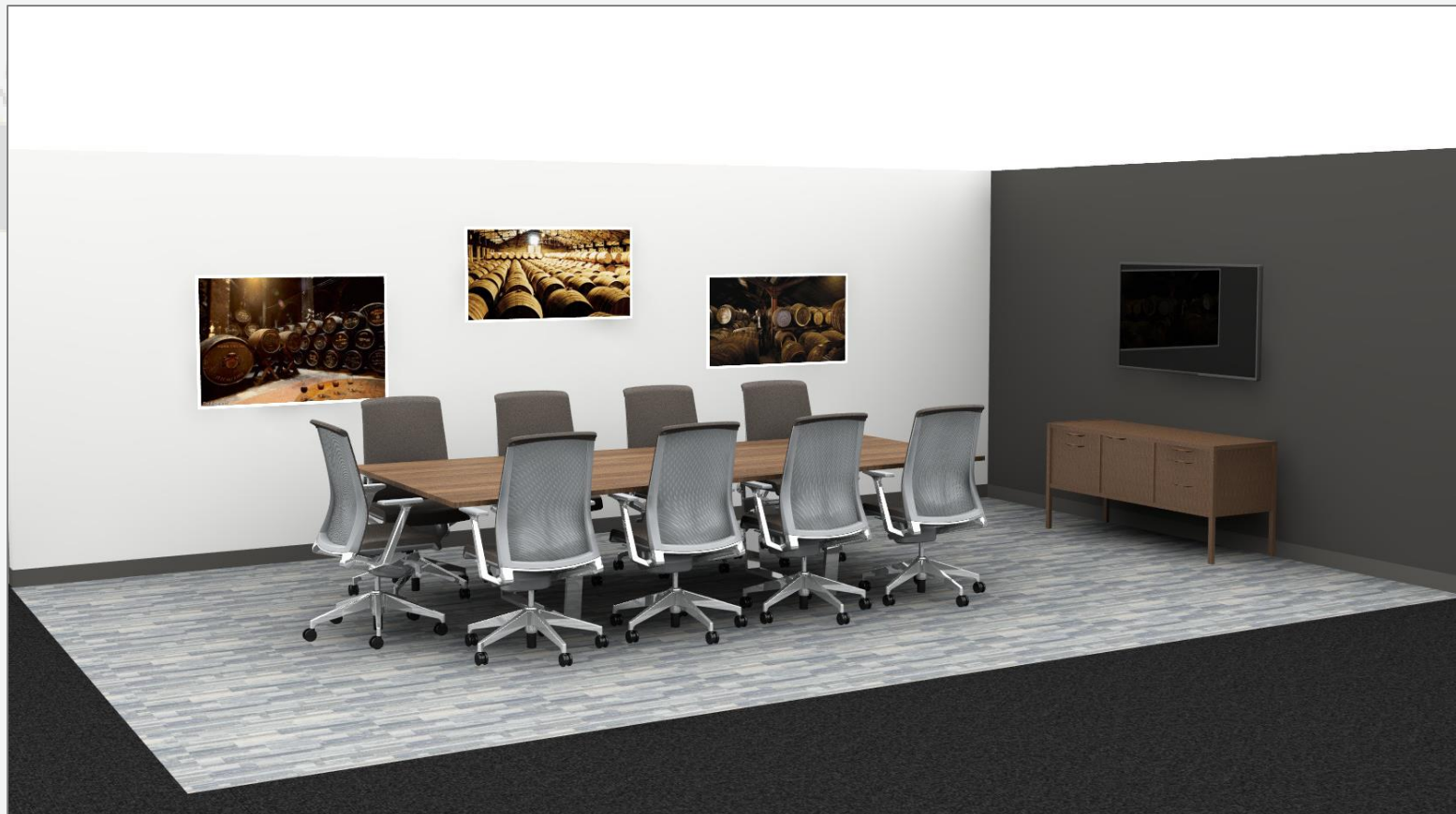
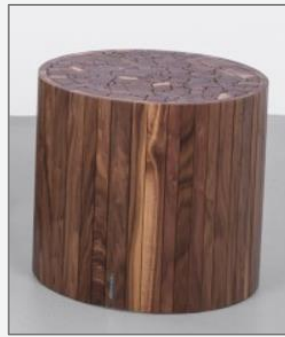
First Floor Furniture Plan

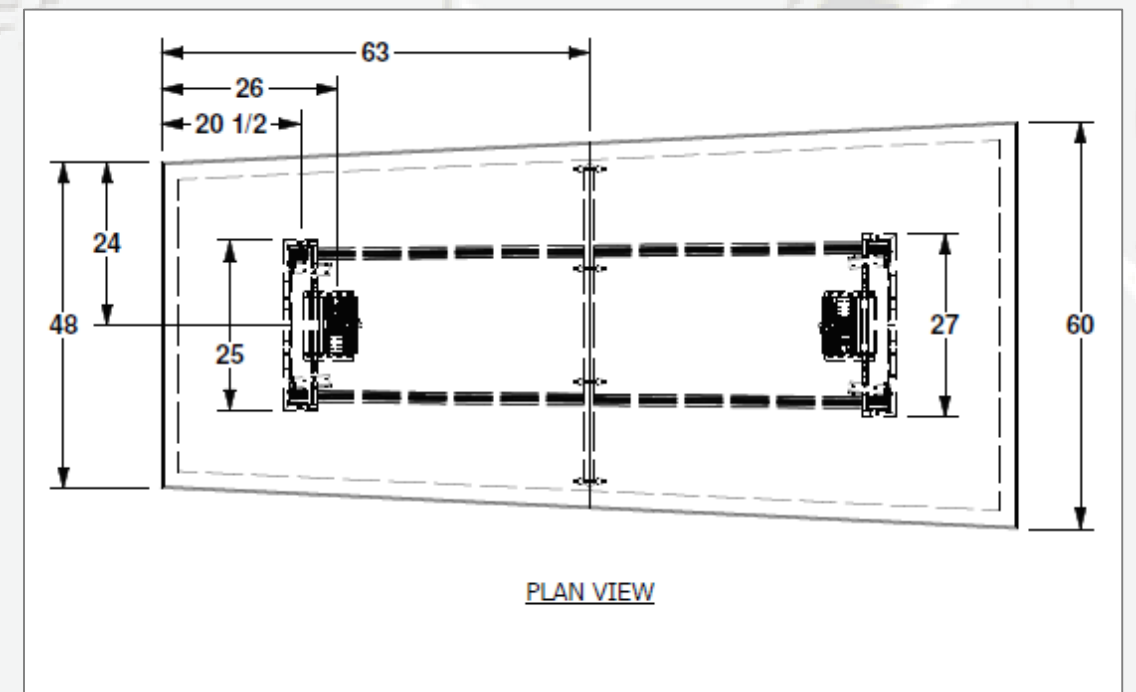
# Badger Liquor Renovation

# Badger Liquor Renovation

## Main Work Stations

- Allow for access to daylight.
- Provide privacy, while being open with 50H panels and frameless glass toppers on all panels.
- Integrate cantilevered, height adjustable tables, over layered storage.
- Include panel-inserted paper management
- Include a layered array of finishes, to compliment and unify both new and existing architecture.

- Include additional storage, height adjustable tables, paper management
- Some offices required floor-to-ceiling movable walls, to accommodate for privacy and future reconfiguration

This area of the space is purposely designed to look like a sophisticated picnic area, while allowing for various types of collaboration



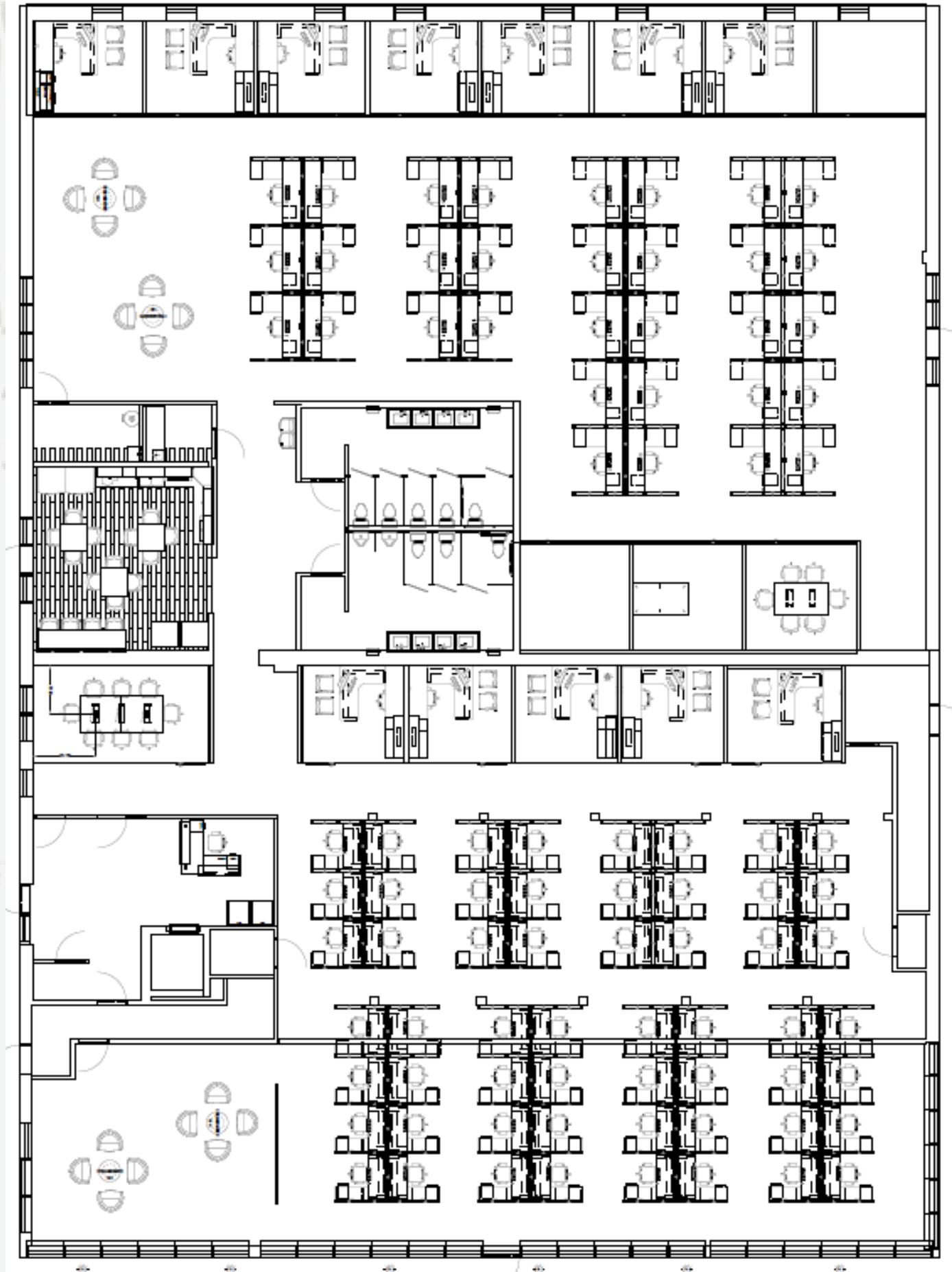
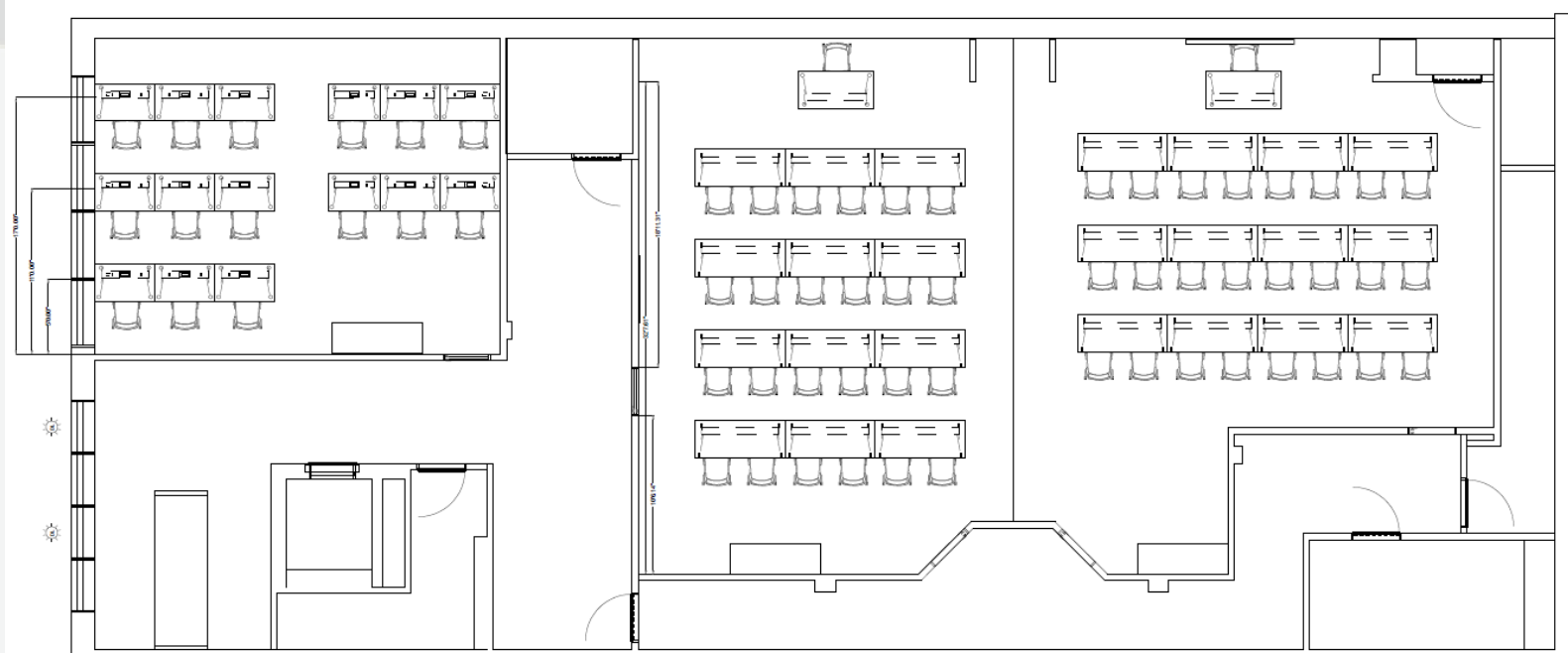

- The Break room serves as the retreat of the building, encouraging friendly communication, access to outside, and a refreshing aesthetic.



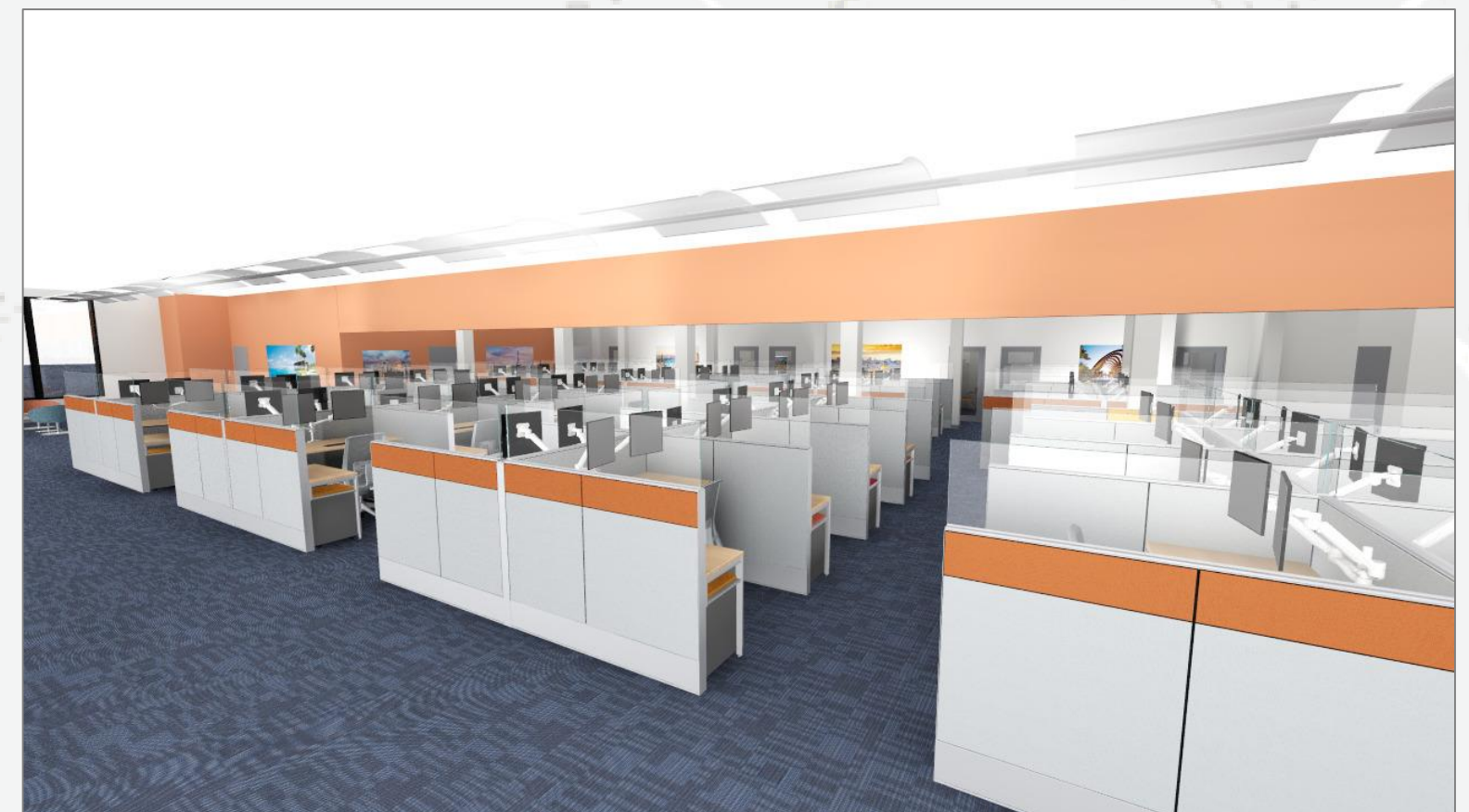
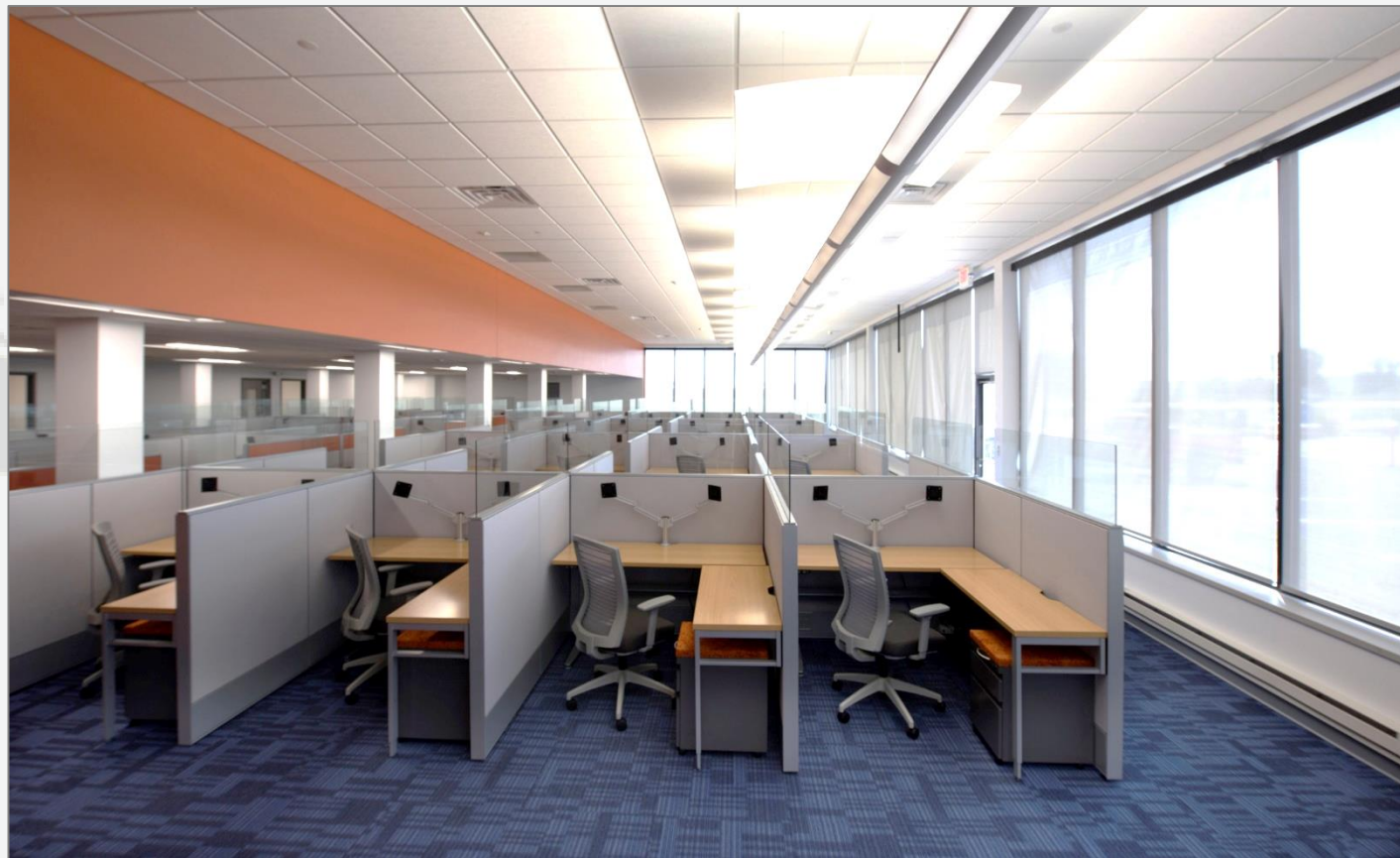

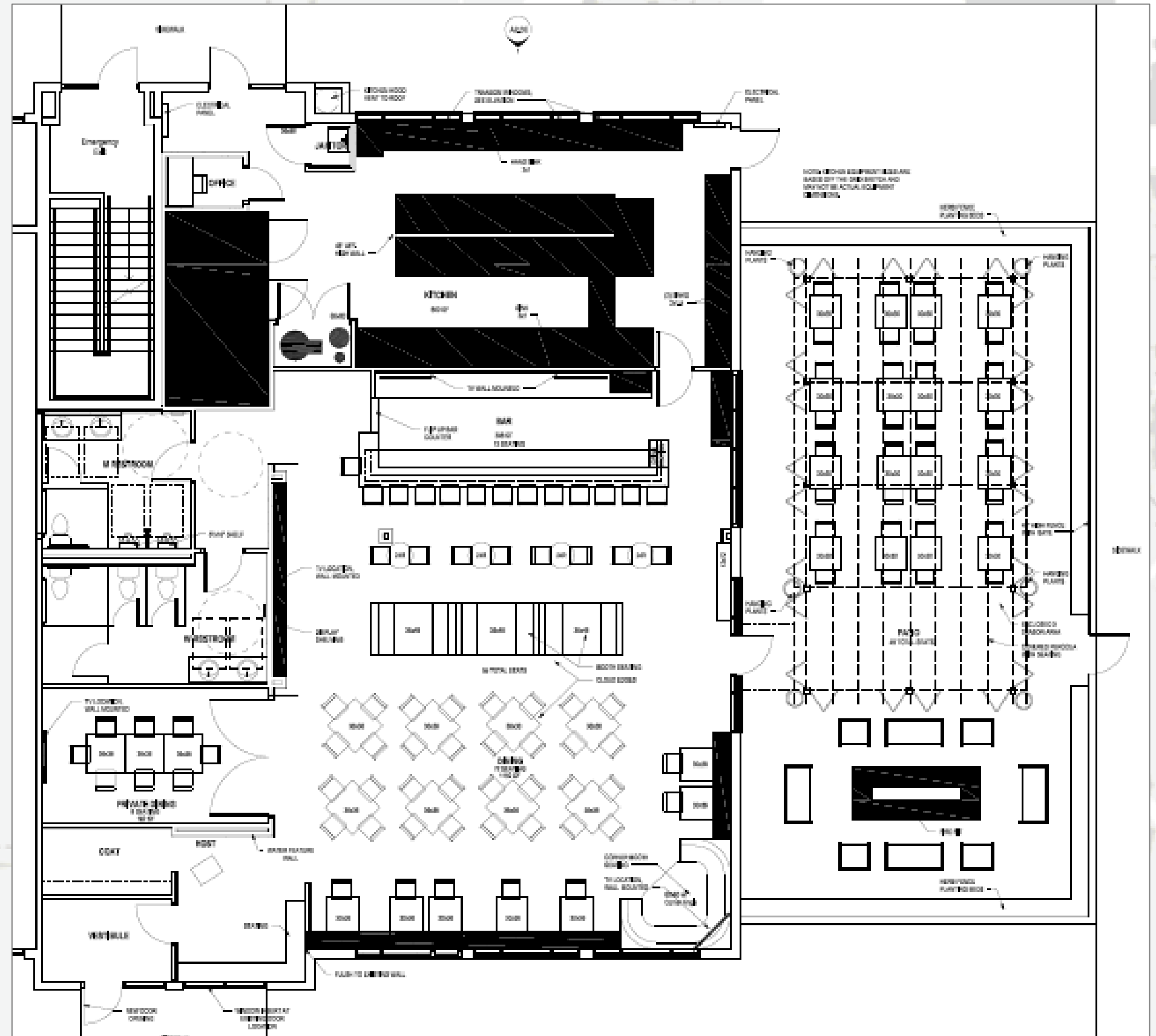

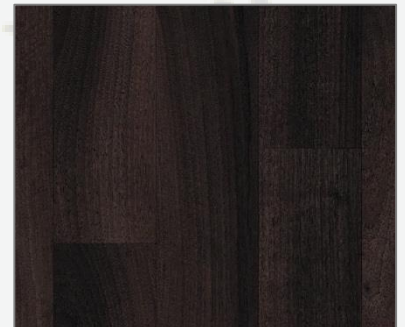
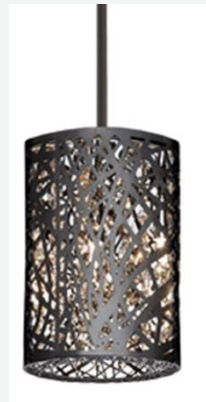

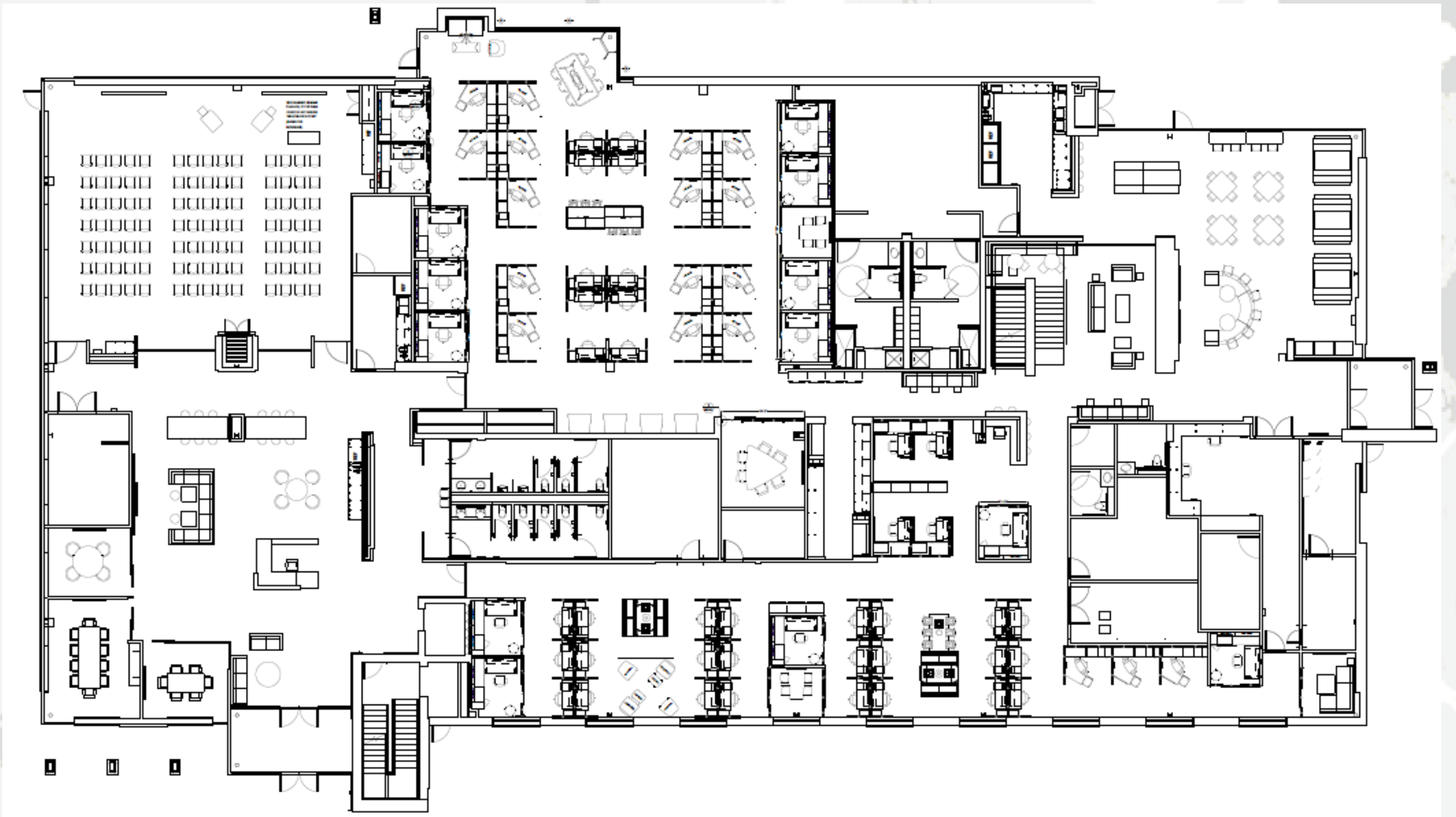

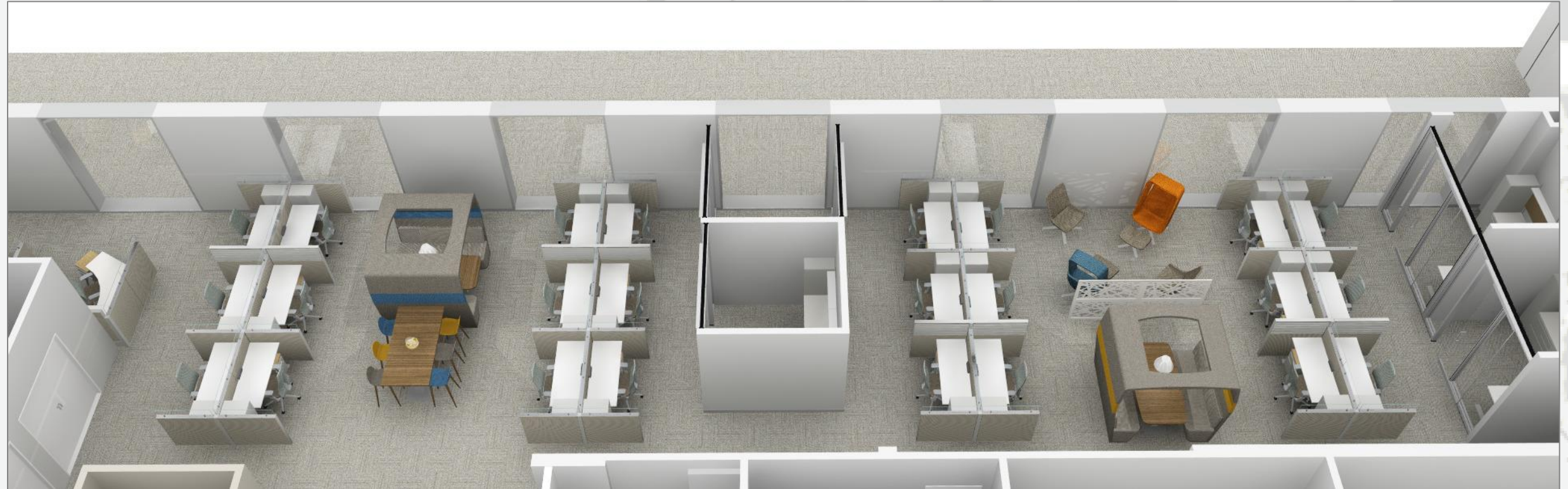
First Floor Furniture Plan

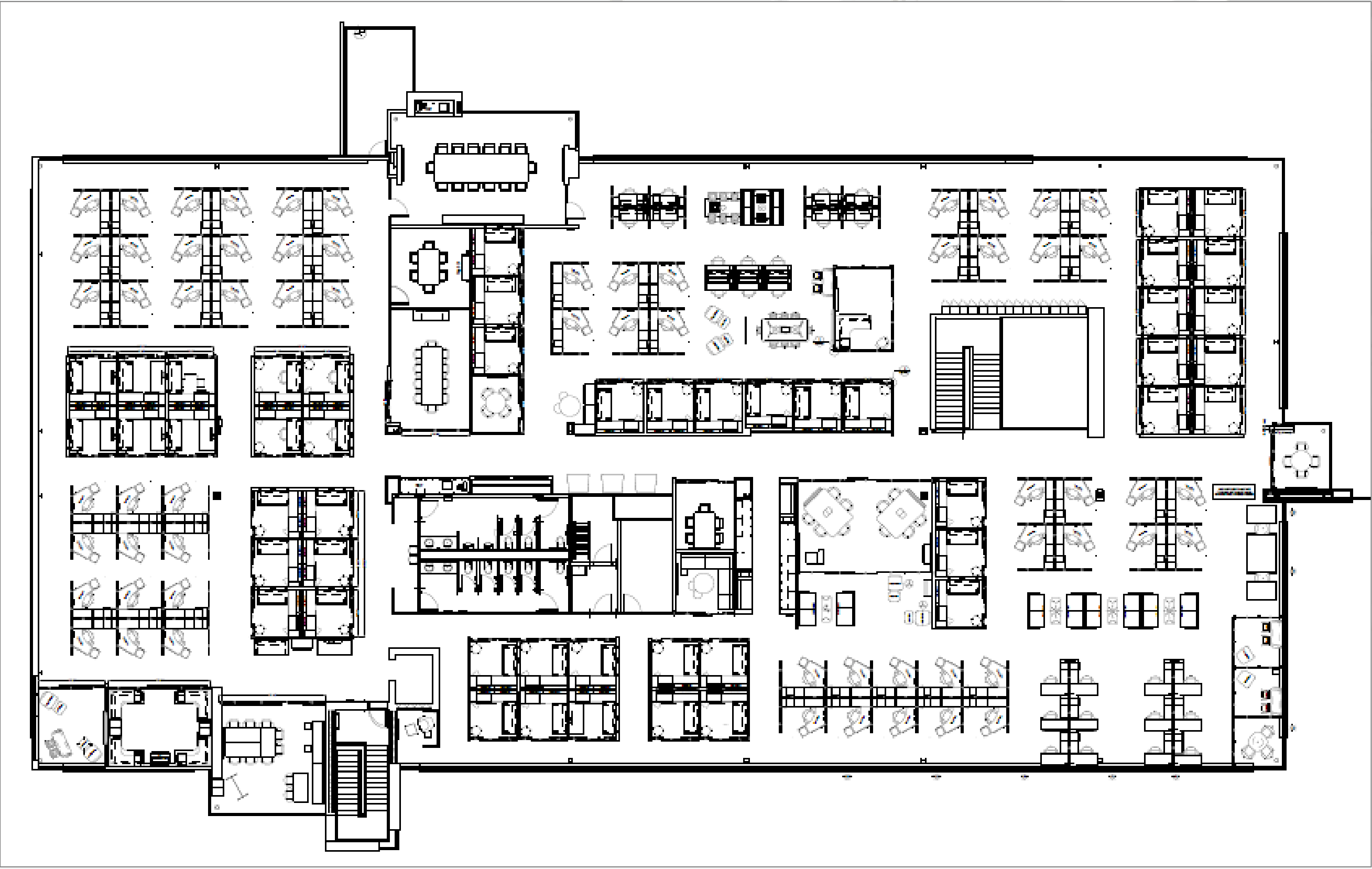

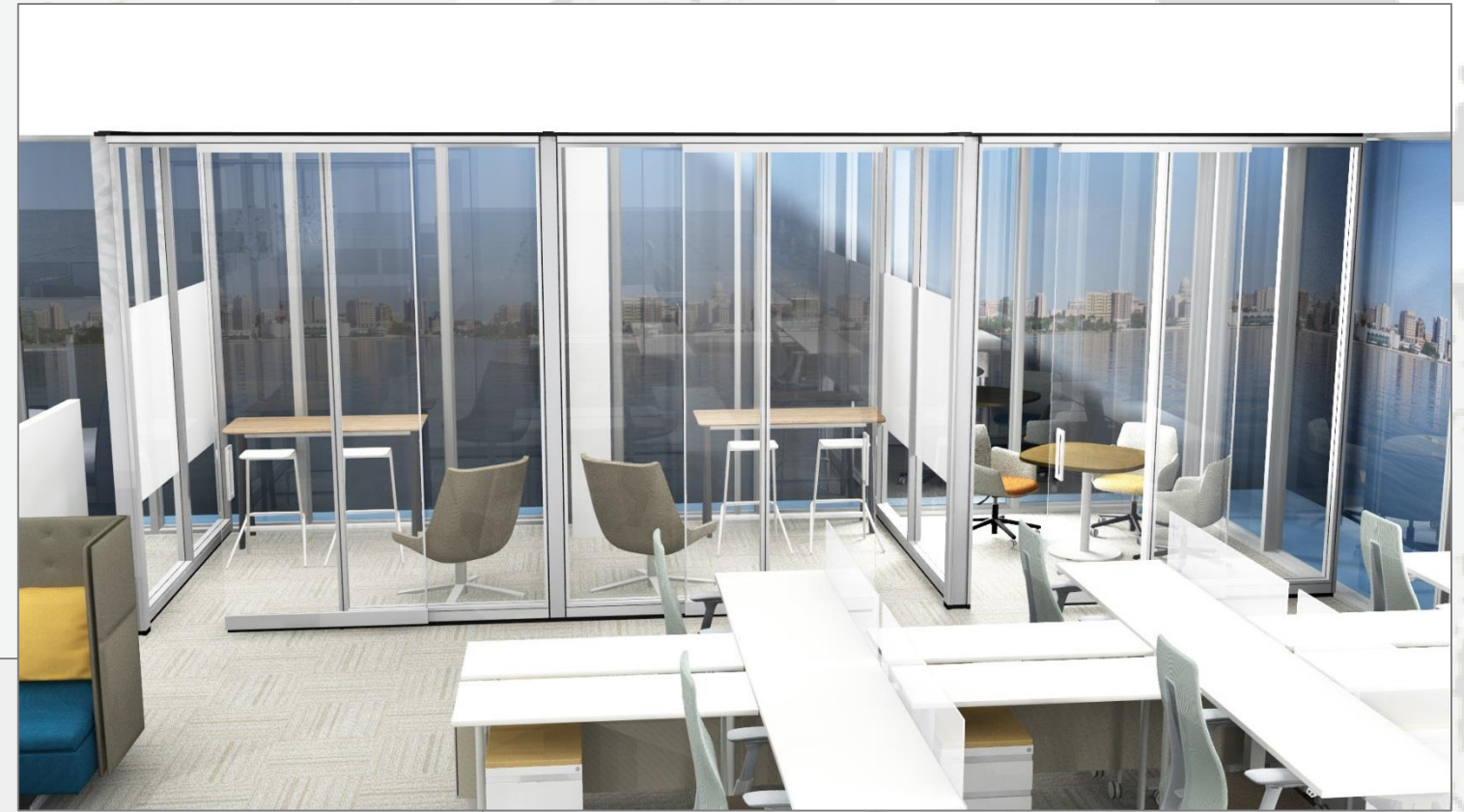

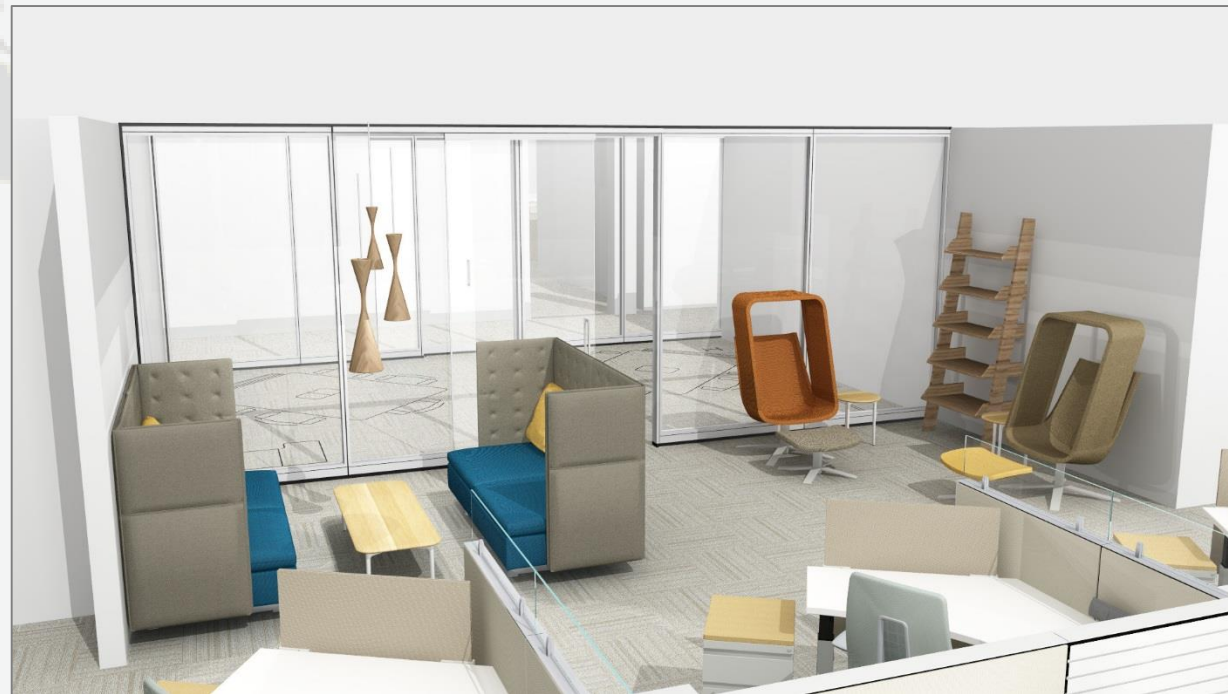
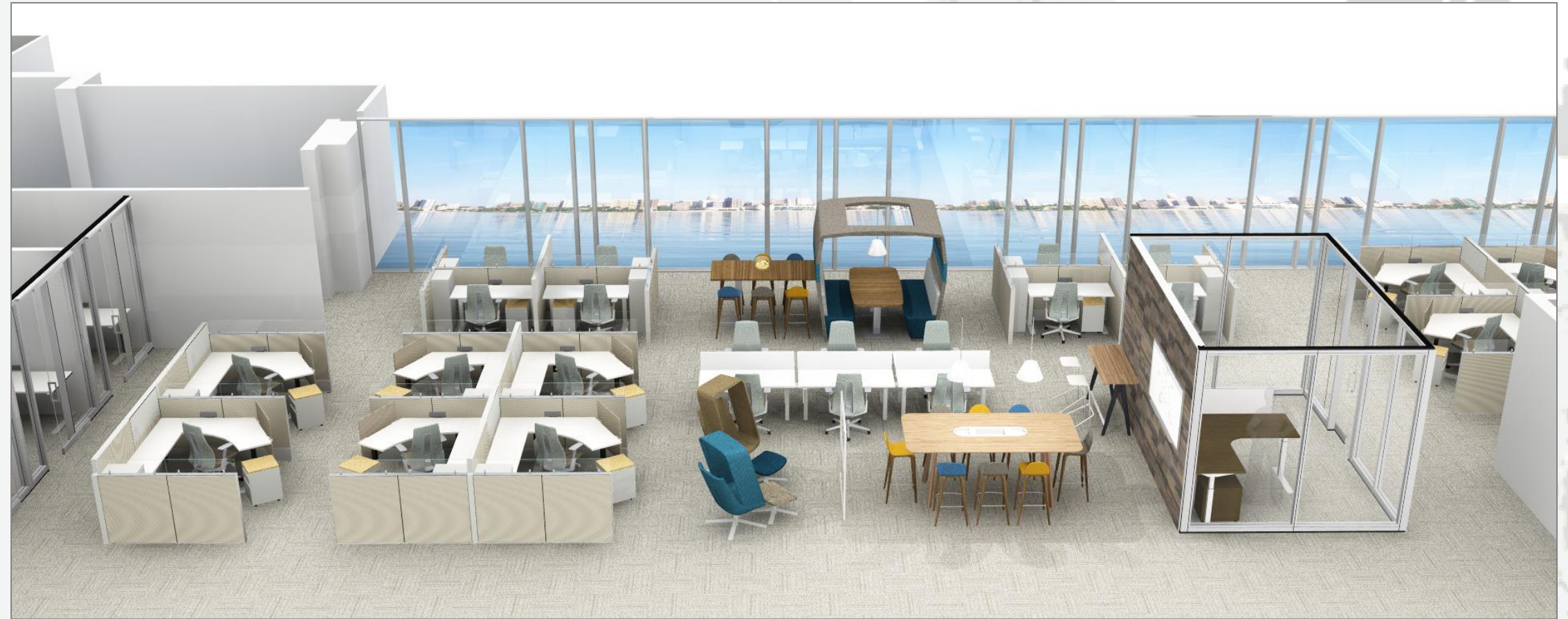
